

2 User Impact

Below are the main areas impacting the employer user experience for this release.

2.1 User Maintenance

A new button has been added to enable keyboard access to change user details. The existing pencil icon now allows changes to the user and a new cog icon has been added to change the user status.



2.2 Accessibility

Keyboard accessibility has been improved in all key user journeys. This means that a mouse is not required to use the portal for these features.

The key user journeys are

- 1. Authentication
- 2. Navigation
- 3. Member and contribution file upload, matching, validation, review and submission
- 4. Viewing employees
- 5. File history
- 6. Employee review (excluding the filtering component)
- 7. Updating users
- 8. Updating employers
- 9. Employee portal

Please note that the following key user journeys have issues (these will be resolved in the next release)

- 1. Adding a user roles selection is not keyboard driven
- 2. Editing in the contributions grid it is not possible to navigate to the contributions grid to edit without use of a mouse

2.3 Other

• Focus visibility has been added to input text boxes for those custodians that define a focus style.



• The scheme name and description on the key data change exception screen will now show the custodian's own name for Scheme and Category



• Dates in the employer review screen have been updated to be in the UK format (e.g. 24/03/2023)

4 Validation And Rule Changes

- A new fn:filteredLookup function has been added which automatically takes into account the lookup filters when validating.
 fn:exists has been removed and will throw an error if used. All rules should use **empty** instead
